Competence Assessor

This program me includes three modules. Upon successful completion and with evidence that the skills and knowledge have been successfully applied in the workplace, participants will receive an OPITO approved competence assessor certificate. This entitles them to assess any area where they themselves are considered to be technically competent.

| Assessment | Participants attending the course will also complete a 45 minutes written exam to test underlying knowledge and demonstrable skills of the learning outcomes of this OPITO approved competence assessor standard. On completion of the course, evidence of assessments generated in the workplace is to be submitted to Falck within 12 months. This evidence will be assessed by Falck/MSTS and if acceptable, the participant will be registered with OPITO and a certificate will be issued. | |
