# **COURSE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

During the course delegates will practice and demonstrate skills of handling fire/emergency related scenarios.

#### LEARNING OUTCOMES

The Damage Control Team Refresher Training delegate's learning outcomes are set out below: Delegate must be able to know and understand:

- 1) How to select and operate the correct firefighting equipment and media to extinguish different types of fires
- 2) Breathing apparatus control board procedures
- 3) How to identify and don the appropriate emergency response PPE required for the OER team member
- 4) The operation, donning and wearer checks of working duration breathing apparatus
- 5) Participation in an incident brief
- 6) Participation as an OER team member in a specified range of fire and non-fire related incidents under the direction of the Offshore Emergency Response Team Leader (OERTL) following safe working practices and procedures
- 7) Selection and use of correct portable fire-fighting equipment
- 8) Selection, operation and flushing of foam firefighting equipment
- 9) Extinguishing of different types of fire and securing the area
- 10) Effective communication with OERTL and OER team members during an incident
- 11) The key considerations and actions whilst entering and working in the incident area
- 12) Correct search and rescue procedures and techniques
- 13) The correct steps involved in initial casualty assessment and recovery
- 14) Participation in a post-incident debrief



# **COURSE OUTLINE**

### The training programme will cover the following topics:

- 1. Practical application
- 2. Fire extinguisher refresher
- 3. Hose running/branch handling/ground monitors
- 4. Breathing apparatus
- Casualty handling
- 6. Valve isolation/overhead flange
- 7. Confined space rescue
- 8. Search and rescue
- 9. Multiple fire scenarios

#### PRE-REQUISITES

All delegates must be in possession of a valid medical certificate and a valid Damage Control Team certificate.

#### TARGET GROUP

This course is designed for personnel designated as Damage Control team members on offshore installations.
